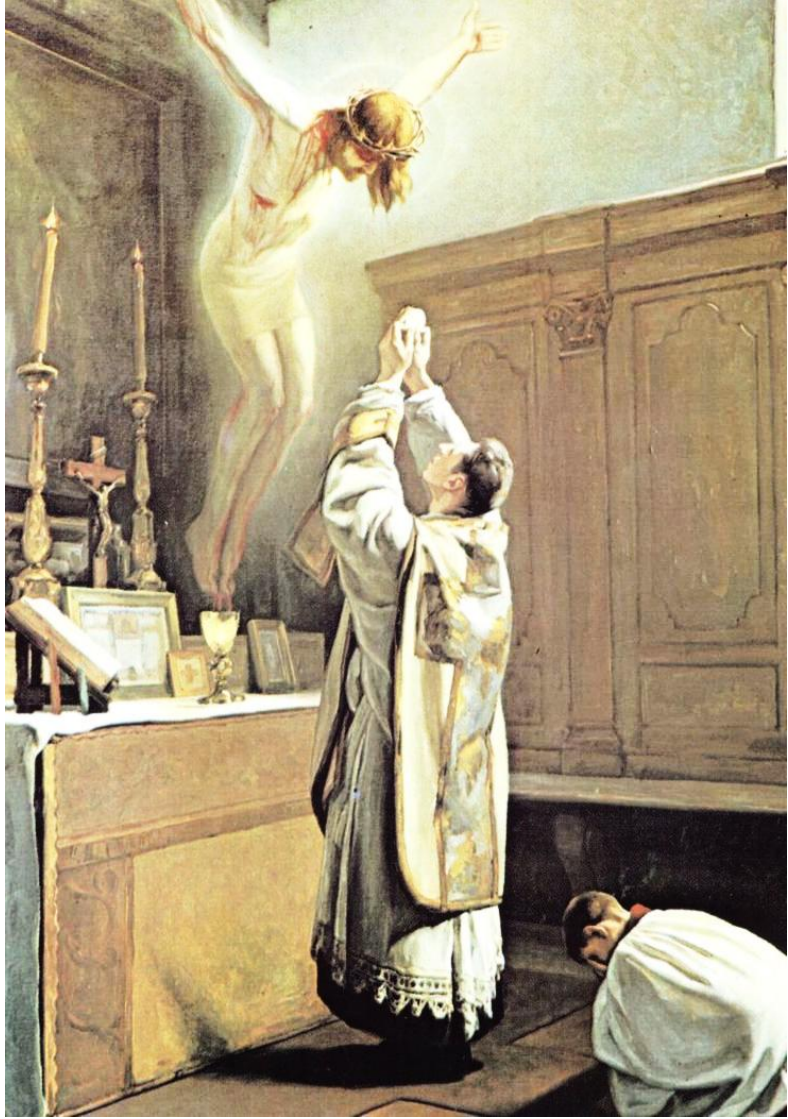




The priest and **Jesus Christ** during Holy Mass according to Roman Canon

1)	The priest walks down the Aisle.	Jesus goes to the Mount of Olives.
2)	The priest begins the Holy Mass.	Jesus begins to pray.
3)	The priest prays: "I confess to Almighty God..."	Jesus prays and sweats Blood.
4)	Comes to the Altar and kisses it.	He is betrayed by the kiss of Judas.
5)	Goes to the place to celebrate the Mass.	He is captured and taken to Annas.
6)	Entrance antiphon.	Falsely accused before Annas.
7)	Says: "Lord, have mercy on us." three times.	Led to Caiaphas. Apostle Peter denies Him three times.
8)	Sings the hymn Gloria.	Remembers the angels' song in worship.
9)	First reading.	Taken before Pilate.
10)	Prayer before the Gospel.	He is led to Herod and mocked.

11)	Says: "The Lord is with you."	Jesus looks at Peter and converts him.
12)	Reads the Gospel.	He is taken back to Pilate and accused before him.
13)	Says the creed.	Jesus declares to Pilate that He is the Son of God.
14)	Uncovers the chalice.	Is shamefully stripped of His garments.
15)	Offers bread and wine.	Is cruelly scourged.
16)	Covers the chalice.	He is crowned with thorns.
17)	Washes his hands.	Found innocent by Pilate.
18)	Says: "Let us pray that my sacrifice and yours may be accepted by Almighty God."	Pilate shows Jesus to the people and says: "Behold the Man."
19)	Invocations before the preface.	He is spit on and mocked.
20)	Preface and praise: "Holy, Holy, Holy..."	Considered worse than the murderer Barabbas and sentenced to death.

21)	Commemoration of the living.	He carries the Cross to Mount Calvary.
22)	Commemoration of the saints and the mystery of the day.	He meets His Sorrowful Mother and pious women.
23)	Blesses the offering of bread and wine.	Jesus is nailed to the Cross.
24)	Lifts the Host.	Exalted on the Cross.
25)	He raises the chalice and prays: “...POURED OUT FOR YOU AND FOR MANY.”	He sheds His Holy Blood from His 5 Wounds.
26)	Says the Mystery of Faith.	Says: <i>“Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.”</i>
27)	Commemoration of the dead.	Jesus prays on the Cross for people.
28)	Prays: “Our Father...”	He says 7 words on the Cross: <i>“My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me?”</i>
29)	Breaks the Host.	Jesus gives His Spirit to God - He dies.
30)	He lets a piece of the Host into the chalice.	He descends into the Abyss.

31)	He says: "Lamb of God..."	The centurion said: "Truly This was the Son of God."
32)	He consumes the Holy Host.	Jesus is taken down from the Cross.
33)	Gives the Holy Communion.	Jesus is laid to the grave.
34)	Cleanses the chalice.	Anointed by pious women.
35)	Covers the chalice.	He rises from the dead.
36)	Antiphon for Holy Communion.	He appears to His Mother Mary and to His disciples.
37)	He says the prayer after Holy Communion.	He reveals Himself to His disciples and teaches them for 40 days more.
38)	He says for the last time, "The Lord be with you."	He says goodbye to the disciples and ascends to Heaven.
39)	Blesses the people.	He sends the Holy Spirit.
40)	Says: "Go, the Sacrifice is complete."	He sends the Apostles all over the world to preach the Gospel.
